Dear Parishioner,

Life in Christ

One of the stunning parts of our faith, is the fact God became man. Without losing any part of his divinity - the Son took on flesh - He had a beating heart, with hands and feet. In this awareness, the passage in Hebrews comes more fully alive, *“a body you prepared for me” (Heb.10:5). For the Lord says to the Israelites in Isaiah, “What to me is the multitude of your sacrifices...? I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs, or of he-goats” (Is. 1:11). Illustrating this point further, the author of Hebrews goes on to explain the passing away of the Old Law, with its sacrifices and burnt offerings - and its completion through Jesus Christ, who offered his body on the cross.*

For a burnt offering was a complete contribution to God, where the whole animal was offered to Him in atonement for sin. This was a foreshadowing of the redemptive act of Christ. As Christians we tap into this redemption through Baptism, Confirmation, and receiving the Holy Eucharist. While being redeemed through these sacraments and the others as well, we also are configured to Christ in a mystical way. For we intently listen to Christ and as the Holy Spirit captures our hearts, our actions imitate Christ in the world through showing mercy to others, in forgiving one another, and when doing what is right and just even when it goes against popular opinion.

In this way we become another Christ for the world, revealing Christ to others by the goodness of our lives, and extending mercy and love to those who think they are eternally doomed because of their sins. Saint Bernard tells us, *“Surely the man who said: My sin is too great to merit pardon, was wrong” (Sermon on the Song of Songs, para. 2). For this reason, in a similar way we know “Sacrifice and offerings God does not desire, but a body He prepared for us” (Ref. Heb.10:5) that we may give ourselves in love and service, accepting our cross, and finding in all circumstances - life in Christ!*

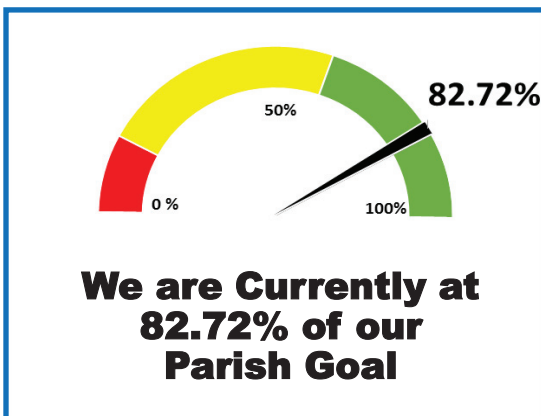

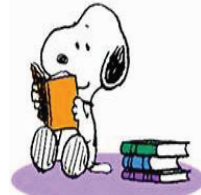
