Dear Parishioner,

The other week the parish leaders of our upcoming Catholic Strong Campaign met with Bishop

Sullivan and number of other parishes that will begin their campaign in March to hear his encouragement as we begin this pledge to the future of Catholicism here in South Jersey. One of our upstanding parishioners, Mary Vey, has agreed to be our parish leader in the campaign and she has assembled a team from our parish to head our local efforts at meeting our goal. Bishop Sullivan has asked the priests and deacons of our diocese to contribute sacrificially to the campaign and I have pledged \$5000.00 over the next five years to meet our goal. I am hoping that most of the families of our parish will be able to also make a similar sacrificial pledge to our campaign! Pledging \$1,000.00 each year over the next five years will help us to meet our parish goal. I ask you to consider this sacrificial pledge to help us meet our needs for the future of our parish and diocese.

The Bishop shared with us at the meeting that he is challenging each of us to contribute to this parish first campaign that gives 70% of all proceeds to our parish needs for the present and future needs of our parishes. The 30% going to the diocese will seek to strengthen our diocesan efforts to increase vocations to the priesthood, expand our access to a Catholic education, bolster our efforts at Evangelization and establish greater outreach to young and old in our diocese. Our own parish hopes and plans will be spelled out in great detail when we begin our campaign in March. I will be meeting personally with a number of families that have been blessed by the Lord to be able to make a significant contribution to our parish campaign in the near future.

I echo the sentiments of Bishop Sullivan made at the recent meeting when he said, “I ask each of you to prayerfully consider how best to contribute to your parish and the entire Catholic community of South Jersey so that we may become stronger missionary disciples. I hope you will ask questions, offer solutions and act as good stewards of our Faith. May we be CATHOLIC STRONG to ensure, now and far into the future, an active, engaged Church in South Jersey.”

I will continue to keep you informed of all our efforts and goals to achieve our own campaign goals to make us Catholic Strong!

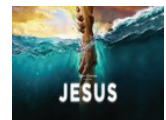

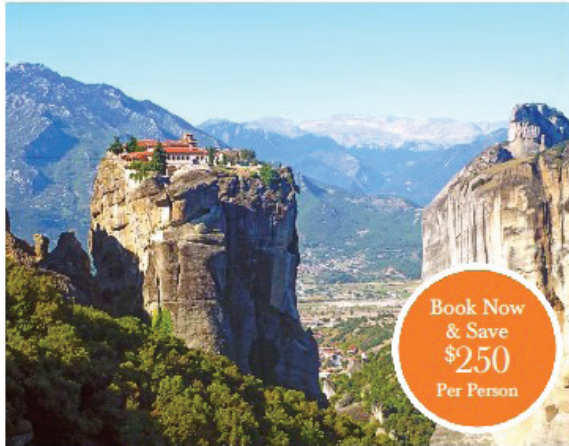

### Lenten Regulations

#### Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

#### Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of **Fast and Abstinence from meat**.

There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

#### Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

#### Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.
