***“I give you a new commandment, says the Lord: love one another as I have loved you.”***

Dear Friends,

The theme for today’s readings center around the command *“Love thy Neighbor.”* Loving your neighbor may not always be easy. We all have persons in our life; family, co-worker, neighbor who annoy or in some cases mistreat us. It’s hard to love them, let alone forgive them. Sometimes it seems impossible. We should pray for guidance and ask God’s assistance in dealing with those we have a hard time dealing with in our daily lives. Through prayer we can find ways to channel our negative feelings towards others. We don’t have to like everyone; however, everyone deserves respect. We should all live by the Golden Rule: *“Do unto others as you would have others do to you.”*

On a recent trip to Florida to visit my terminally ill brother, I encountered a number of people who truly love their neighbor. I went with my brother to his latest chemo treatment and was overwhelmed by the love and compassion everyone gave not only to him, but to me. It began with the gentlemen at the car valet and continued throughout our entire visit (4 hours). I watched in awe how the employees genuinely cared and respected each person who walked through the door. Their words and more importantly their actions, spoke volumes. As we were leaving a woman showed me a tree filled with small bags of homemade earrings. I was told to take a bag (no payment or donation permitted) as a keepsake of my visit. Their acts of kindness were not forced or a condition of their employment. They gave from the heart.

We too can *“Love thy Neighbor”* with random acts of kindness. Did you know that an act of kindness can: decrease stress, boost happiness, lower blood pressure, and inspire more kindness? A simple smile to the pre-occupied cashier, holding the door for the elderly & infirmed, and a heartfelt greeting to the person sitting next to you at Church can go a long way. Take the time and help your neighbor. Your random act of kindness may be what puts a smile on someone’s face. We have no idea how their day is going. When we love our neighbor, we love God. In the end we will all be judged by how we treated others.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflections

#### 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Provide materials for each family member to cut out a paper heart shape. Invite each family member to think of one person in their life that is difficult to deal with and write the name of the person on their heart. Perhaps it is a colleague or a classmate. Maybe it is a family member. Once everyone has written a name, pray together, asking God to bless these people.
- Think about how you live together as a family. Talk about how your family follows Jesus' teaching to "bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." Write these examples on a piece of paper and hang it in your home where it can serve as a reminder to always act with mercy.
- Jesus teaches that if we "give, gifts will be given" to us. Invite each family member to share about a time when they were generous or did an act of service and they received gifts in return.

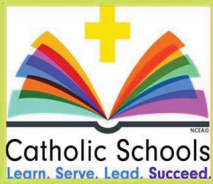

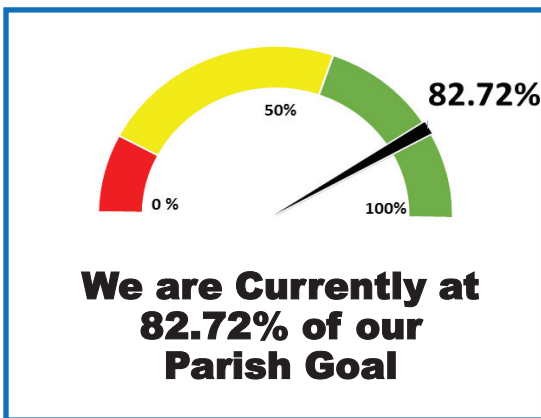
