Letter From Carolyn Miller, Parish Catechetical Leader

Dear Friends,

“Go in peace to love and serve the Lord.” I’m betting that’s a phrase very familiar to all of you. Yes, of course it is. We hear it at the closing of mass. The instruction to go and do good. But how do we react to that? How do we live it? Do we take God’s peace and love and really serve the Lord, through His people, during the week?

The Mass is a great source of nourishment for our faith and we come each week to celebrate, to be renewed and to confirm that faith. We participate with other believers in the great mystery and sacrifice. And then we leave. We rush out, often leaving the essence of the mass behind; forgetting that our living the mass has just begun, not ended.

“Why did God make me?” Many remember that Baltimore Catechism question. And its answer: “God made me to know Him, love Him and to serve Him in this world so I might be happy with Him in the next.” See the connection? It’s all in that word “Service! In other words, putting our faith into action in whatever way we can to further the kingdom. This is what God instructs us to do.

Saint Mother Teresa put it quite simply, ‘Just do little things with great love.’ Little acts add up and make an important impact; a real difference.

I believe that and I believe that you do too. We all have gifts and talents to share and your parish needs each of you to do that. I believe that many of you will respond when asked to help our parish reach out in hospitality and service. We need all of you, VIPs---Very Important Parishioners---who will volunteer for some parish service at least once a year. If everyone would do that---volunteer just once a year---we will build a dynamic faith-alive parish; a parish built on faith, worship, and service. Consider this your official invitation to participate in whatever way you can in our service opportunities as they unfold throughout the year.

Let me take this opportunity to thank those VIPs who are making soup or desserts or donating rolls for our Soup & Service this Wednesday, Feb. 28 at 6 p.m. in Kelly Hall. This is an opportunity to share a meal and reflect on a Lenten topic with other faith communities on the island. Please come and join us in this Lenten experience.

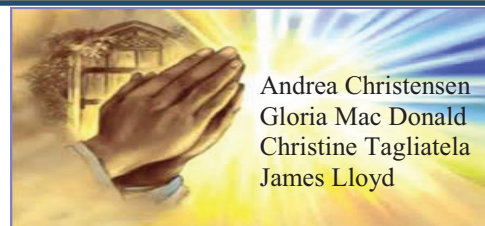

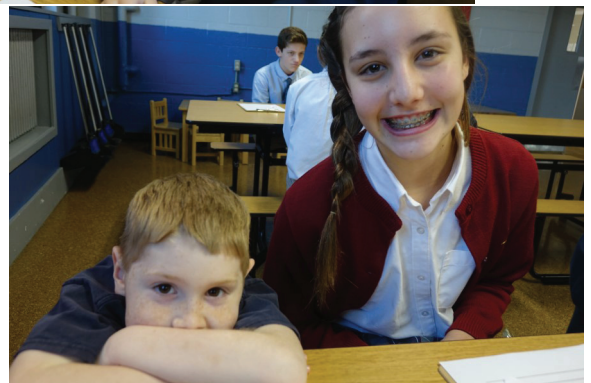

Lenten Regulations

Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.
