Dear Parishioners,

Faith is an obedient response to the call of God and therefore, it opens up a channel for the redemptive action of God in history and in the world. All three readings for the liturgy of this weekend introduce us to another aspect of faith. The First reading teaches us how our faith has an impact on others and how its effects can transform the world. Because Abram had faith and obeyed God's commandments, God was able to create in him a great nation and a blessing for the world. The whole story about Abraham's life and obedience to the Lord can be understood as a response to the call of God. Paul has used the experience of Abram as the paradigm of faith to teach us about the Lenten transformation expected of us. We are transformed when we recognize the hand of a loving, providing and disciplining God behind all our hardships, pain and suffering and try our best to grow in holiness by cooperating with the grace of God given to us through Jesus and his Gospel.

Jesus took his friends to the mountain, there he was identified by the Heavenly Voice as the "Son of God". He was transfigured right there in front of them. What an amazing experience to allow the Lord to be transfigured in our lives and in our world! This is a manifestation or a revelation of who Jesus really is. The Gospel gives us a glimpse of the Heavenly glory awaiting those who do God's will by putting their trust and faith in Him. Just as the Transfiguration of Jesus strengthened the Apostles in their time of trial, each Holy Mass should be our source of Heavenly strength against our own temptations and a source for the renewal of our lives during Lent.

When we enter into deep communion with Jesus through prayer, alms-giving, fasting and receiving daily Eucharist that is a source of daily transformation of both our minds and hearts. As disciples of Jesus we should be able to see Jesus in our brothers and sisters with whom we come in contact each day. Each Sacrament that we receive transforms us. Baptism, for example, transforms us into sons and daughters of God and heirs of the heavenly kingdom. Confirmation makes us the temples of the Holy Spirit. By the Sacrament of Reconciliation, God brings us, the sinner, back to the path of holiness. By receiving in faith the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, we are spiritually, and sometimes physically healed, and our sins are forgiven.

My brothers and sisters God invites all of us in moments of doubt, pain and suffering, disappointment and despair, which are mountain-top experiences, to reach out to God and listen to His consoling words: "This is my beloved son/daughter in whom I am well pleased."

Many blessings to you all and have a blessed Lenten experience with the Lord as we continue to reflect upon His seven last words on the cross every Friday before the Stations of the Cross.

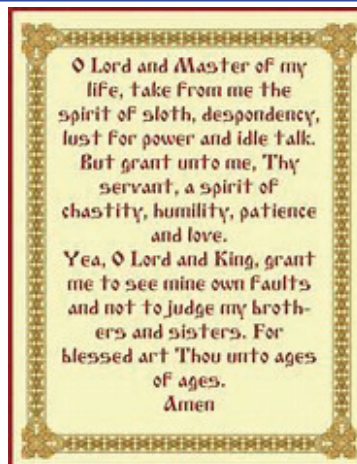

### Lenten Regulations

#### Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

#### Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*.

There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

#### Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in lent)

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

#### Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season.

Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter season.

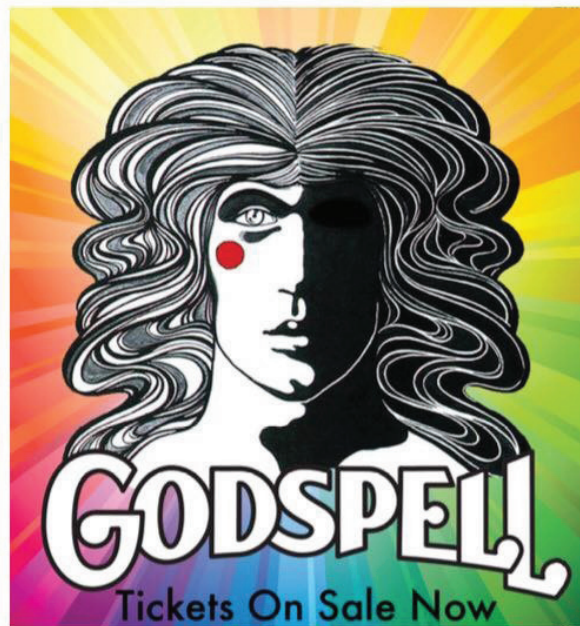
