Dear Parishioner,

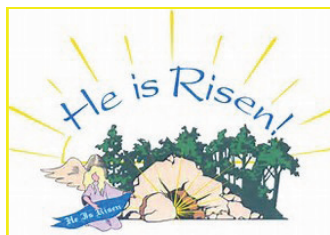
It is with great joy that I join my voice to the chorus of voices that span the over 2000 year of our history in announcing the cause of our joy as a believing community, that, "Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!" This Jesus who died for the sins of humanity returned to us alive on the third day, glorious and triumphant, victorious over sin and death! The Resurrection of Christ is the most transformative event in human history and the heart and foundation of our holy faith. As St. Paul says if Christ has not been raised from the dead, then our preaching is empty and our faith meaningless, yet we know through the witness of the first believers, he returned to us as he promised.

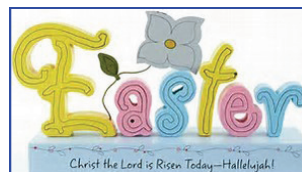

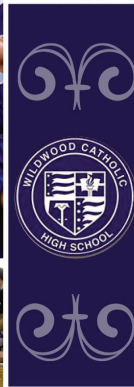
