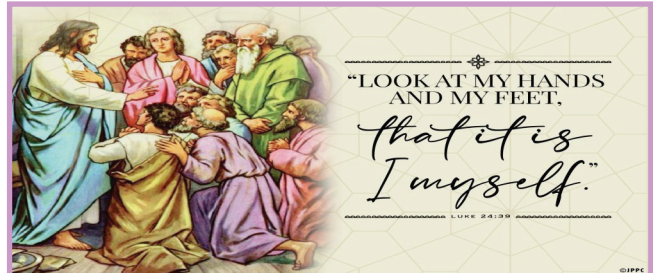

Peace to you, your family and friends!

Alleluia the Lord is RISEN and is with us Alleluia! The Alleluias of Easter Sunday are still resounding. The readings these Sundays during Eastertime we see Jesus sharing with his apostles especially at the table. All through the Gospels we see Jesus eating at table with his apostles, sinners, tax collectors and the ones no one would invite to their table. The two apostles on the road to Emmaus recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread, in today's gospel Jesus asks "Have you anything here to eat?" Reading I : [Acts 3:13-15, 17-19](#)
God raised Christ from the dead.

- In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter explains that Jesus is the fulfillment of the ancient messianic promises.
- Jesus, the Messiah, who died and was raised to new life, brought a new life of peace and right relationship with God.
- Through Jesus, God's merciful love is available to all those who seek it.

Reading II: [1 John 2:1-5](#)
Whoever keeps God's word has love made perfect.

- The first part of the second reading reminds believers that sin still exists in the world.
- Believers must walk in light because God is light.
- Christ, who lives in a totally loving relationship with the Father, is also the Advocate who pleads our cause with the Father.

Gospel: [Luke 24:35-48](#)
He stood in their midst.

- The author of today's Gospel attempts to tell us that Jesus' resurrection involves the whole person, body and spirit.
- After his resurrection, when Jesus eats with the disciples, they recognize him in the breaking of bread.
- Life in Christ is a life of forgiveness and peace.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection
 Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Ask each member of your family to discuss one way in which the Resurrection of Jesus makes their relationship with God stronger. What would happen if they were not aware of Jesus' life, teachings, and Resurrection? In what way would God appear different if he did not possess the qualities of each person of the Trinity?
- Discuss how it is sometimes hard to see Jesus' presence in certain situations that occur in our world. Give examples of specific situations. In what way could family members see Jesus' presence in similar situations in the future?
- Make a list of life events that have occurred in the history of your family that were examples of God's mercy. Discuss why that mercy was not deserved. Does God decide that one person (or persons) deserves mercy over another?

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

In about 8 weeks, we will celebrate the great feast of **Corpus Christi**. This feast celebrates the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Pope Urban IV on August 11, 1264 pronounced in a papal bull that this feast will be celebrated the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, which is the Sunday after Pentecost. The Holy Father requested that a Dominican friar from the University of Paris, Thomas Aquinas, compose the liturgy. This included the prayers and hymns to be used during the Mass

St. Thomas Aquinas, known as the Angelic Doctor, wrote hymns and prayers that were theologically rich and expressed the mysteries of our faith to the best of his ability during his time. Some of us may even know some of his hymns without even knowing it! Have you ever heard of Panis Angelicus? Have you ever attended benediction? The prayer the priest or deacons says after “Let us pray” was written by Aquinas and is the opening collect for the Mass on Corpus Christi. Remember the hymn that the choir was singing on Holy Thursday during the procession of the Blessed Sacrament? The hymn is called Pange Lingua with the last two verses being the most popular (Tantum Ergo).

The Angelic Doctor certainly left his mark on the liturgical celebration of the Eucharist. One of my favorite hymns is Adoro Te Devote. To help prepare ourselves to celebrate this great Solemnity, I would like to share a reflection each week with you. Starting next week, I will begin my reflections. Please pray with and for me!

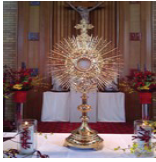
