Message from Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Friends,

During this past winter, I had the opportunity to read *Everyone Leads* by Chris Lowney. It is an inspiring work on revitalizing the Catholic Church. One of the main points made in this book is the need to empower each other for leadership in the Church. You may say that you don't see yourself as a leader, but I invite you to reflect on who Jesus chose to lead his ministry. He chose simple fisherman. He welcomed women. He recruited sinners and corrupt tax collectors. He healed people who others avoided. None of Jesus' followers were ready, but all were willing to say YES – yes, I will help you build your Church.

Today, more than ever before, Jesus needs you to say YES. Our universal Church faces many crises that impact us locally, too. While we each need to follow our own hearts, this is not the time to slip away from your parish or your relationship with God. The time is upon us for the Church leadership to welcome the courageous collaboration of lay women and men. As the baptized, you are the Church community, the People of God. By your baptism, you are called to lead and to bring your gifts to the Church and to each other. Ponder the Catechism's powerful assertion about the baptized: "By Baptism, they share in the priesthood of Christ, in his prophetic and royal mission". Together, we are called to lead the Catholic Church into the future so that our children will come to know Christ as the Lord and Savior of their lives.

If you don't know where to start, I have an excellent recommendation. Investigate the ministries that we offer within the parish and our schools. These opportunities are always a good jumping off point for involvement within your parish community. Perhaps, you even have a ministry that you would like to start within the parish. If so, give the parish office a call and we can schedule a meeting to discuss. Shortly, the publication of a parish handbook will become a reality. This publication will include, amongst other items, a list of all the ministries that we offer and a point of contact. In the meantime, feel free to call the parish office or visit the Welcome Center and we will direct you accordingly. The opportunity exists to serve each other, to engage with each other, and to continue to welcome each other into, or even back to, this community.

There are many ways to cultivate the seeds of faith and leadership our gracious Lord has planted in you. The important thing is to make a commitment to give just a bit of your time or to take one small step in trying something new. Notre Dame de la Mer is ready to welcome your unique way of living your faith.

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Why does the priest wear different color vestments?

Green: Priests wear green vestments for Masses in Ordinary Time. Green symbolizes hope and life.

White: White is used for a number of feast days, including feasts of the Lord (except for feasts of the Passion), Mary, saints who were not martyrs, and angels. Additionally, it is used during the seasons of Christmas and Easter. White symbolizes joy, light, and purity.

Violet: The color violet is used during the seasons of penitence, Advent and Lent. It can also be used for Masses for the dead. Violet represents penance and mourning. Sometimes, blue will be used in the Eastern rite for Advent instead of violet to symbolize the different penitential nature of Advent.

Red: Red represents both the Holy Spirit and suffering. Priests wear red vestments on Pentecost and confirmations, but also on feasts of suffering, such as feasts of the Lord's Passion and feasts of the martyrs.

Along with these four main colors, there are also rose vestments and black vestments in the Roman rite. Priests may wear rose vestments, symbolizing joy, on Gaudete Sunday during Advent and Laetare Sunday during Lent. They may wear black vestments, representing mourning, on All Souls Day. Liturgical colors and the use of different vestments represent more than just small details to be remembered. The Mass is a sensory experience in which we touch and taste the Eucharist, smell the incense, hear the music and prayers, and see everything happening at the altar. The use of color heightens our experience by evoking certain moods and feelings to contribute to the whole experience of the sacrifice of the Mass.
