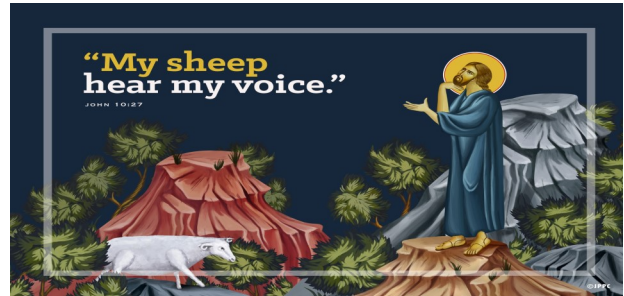

## *From the Desk of Kevin Quinn - Parish Administrator*

Dear Friends,

As many of you know, May is a month traditionally dedicated to honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary. In our churches and homes, we celebrate May as a “Marian month,” with May processions, May crownings, and other popular devotions in honor of the Mother of God. Our parish has a unique connection with Mary as our namesake refers to her. In case you were unaware “Notre Dame de la Mer” translates to “Our Lady of the Sea” a reference to the Virgin Mary dating back to ancient times. Of course, our church names also connect. The Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is named for Mary’s divine gift as the Mother of God as she was assumed into heaven, body and soul. Our St. Ann Church is named, as such, in honor of Mary’s own mother, St. Ann.

During the month of May, the Church calls us to open our hearts in a special way to Mary. Her presence in our lives is a motherly presence. In fact, we call her, among other references, Our Blessed Mother. Mary was full of unconditional love for her Son, supporting him in his teaching, preaching and even his ultimate sacrifice. It was from the cross, that Jesus gave us the beautiful gift of his mother to be our mother too. We know of Jesus’ words to John, as written in John 19:25-27, were also addressed to all of us: Behold your mother!

Today, we celebrate Mother’s Day! It is very fitting that we celebrate Mother’s Day during the Marian month. As we honor the Mother of God, our spiritual mother, today we specifically honor our earthly mothers and mother figures, and even the mother of our own children. Mary’s grace-filled motherhood shows us how to be filled with gratitude for all of our motherly figures – both living and deceased. We can honor Mary and follow her example of love by genuinely thanking the own “mothers” in our lives for their support of us. We remember with gratitude and affection these women through material gifts, flowers, or cards. We can also honor them through our prayers. Take the opportunity to thank God for the gift of our mothers. For many of us we can then thank them for passing on the precious gift of faith to us. Be sure to also thank them for their generosity and self-giving love.

In my own life, my mother is a source of inspiration. I look back at the sacrifices that she has made for me along the way. My parents separated when I was three years old, and though I was blessed with a situation that allowed me to have both of my parents in my life, readily, it was my mother that had the daily responsibility of raising me. I am sure she would refer to it as a joy, though I know it must have been, at times, quite burdensome. If you knew me as a youngster, you would probably agree! I, like many of you, probably don’t acknowledge my gratitude enough. I can remember at times my mother telling me that her love was unconditional. As a parent myself I understand wholly what that statement means. I THANK her for her generosity and self-giving love.

As we spend the day celebrating the mothers in our lives, let us also remember the special place that the Blessed Mother has in our faith. She can help us find and say yes to God’s calling in our own lives.

## Family Reflection Corner

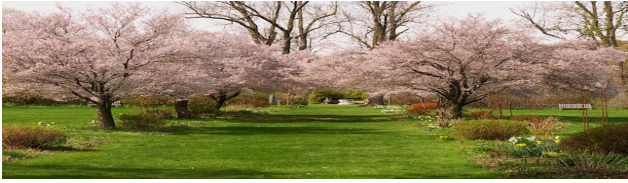
### Weekly Readings Reflection

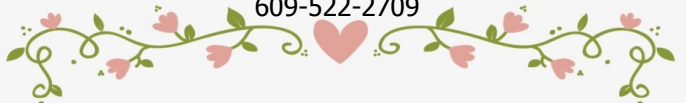

## **LITURGY CORNER**

### **Why does Mary have a special role in helping us?**

As the Mother of God, the Virgin Mary has a unique position among the saints, indeed, among all creatures. She is exalted, yet still one of us.

Redeemed by reason of the merits of her Son and united to Him by a close and indissoluble tie, she is endowed with the high office and dignity of being the Mother of the Son of God, by which account she is also the beloved daughter of the Father and the temple of the Holy Spirit. Because of this gift of sublime grace she far surpasses all creatures, both in heaven and on earth. At the same time, however, because she belongs to the offspring of Adam she is one with all those who are to be saved.

Mary embraces God's will and freely chooses to cooperate with God's grace, thereby fulfilling a crucial role in God's plan of salvation. Throughout the centuries, the Church has turned to the Blessed Virgin in order to come closer to Christ. Many forms of piety toward the Mother of God developed that help bring us closer to her Son. In these devotions to Mary, "while the Mother is honored, the Son, through whom all things have their being and in whom it has pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell, is rightly known, loved and glorified and . . . all His commands are observed."<sup>33</sup> The Church honors her as the Mother of God, looks to her as a model of perfect discipleship, and asks for her prayers to God on our behalf.

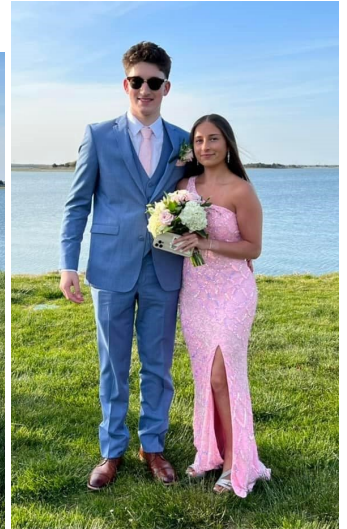

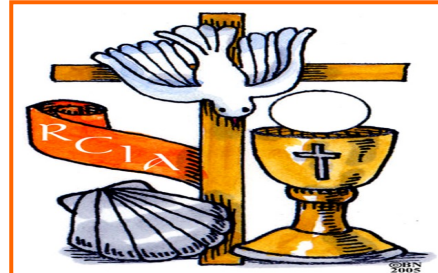
