### Reading I : [Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48](#)

*A person from any nation is called to follow Christ.*

- Peter baptizes Cornelius and his household, and he declares that God is not partial but loves all people.

*Let us love one another.*

- The reading from 1 John is part of a series of statements that end with the crucial reminder that love comes from God.
- The author wants to point out how much God loves us.
- God demonstrated the extent of his love by sending his Son to give his life for us.

### Gospel: [John 15:9-17](#)

*So I have loved you.*

- Today's Gospel continues the theme of love with the message that God has loved us, so therefore, we must love one another.
- Love demands all we are, to the point of giving up life for the sake of another.
- God is the source and object of our love.

## **Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !**

### **Adoro Te Devote**

***On the cross they godhead made no sign to men. Here thy very manhood steals from the human ken:  
Both are my confession, both are my belief, and I pray the prayer of the dying thief.***

Recall a few weeks, we heard the Passion read on Palm Sunday and Good Friday. In these passages from Scripture, we see a suffering Jesus. He had a crown of thorns stabbed into his head and received whips on his back and side from the scourging at the pillar. Then they nail him to a cross. If we were just passing by this event, we would not think that this man was anything more than a criminal of some sort.

We know, however, who he is! We know he is the Word made flesh sent down from heaven to redeem us from sin. By becoming man and dying, he reversed the sin of Adam. Now, we may partake in this new life in Christ Jesus. We are sustained in this life through the sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Reconciliation. His divinity was not visible on the cross out of humility and obedience to the Father.

In the Holy Eucharist, Jesus does not show his divinity and humanity. Instead, we rely on his words. We rely on his grace. Why would he hide these from us? This is my favorite verse from the hymn, so I have reflected on it several times. One of the reasons he hides his humanity and divinity, I believe, is because he wants our faith to be pure. We do not need to rely on our senses to believe in him. The dying thief asked Jesus to remember him when he enters his Kingdom. Did the thief know Jesus? We don't know. As he was dying, though, the thief saw Christ for who he is—the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

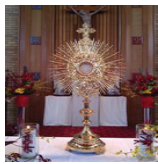
