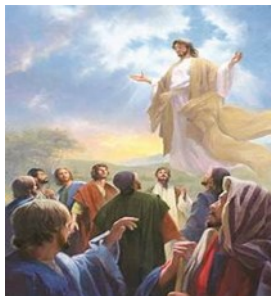

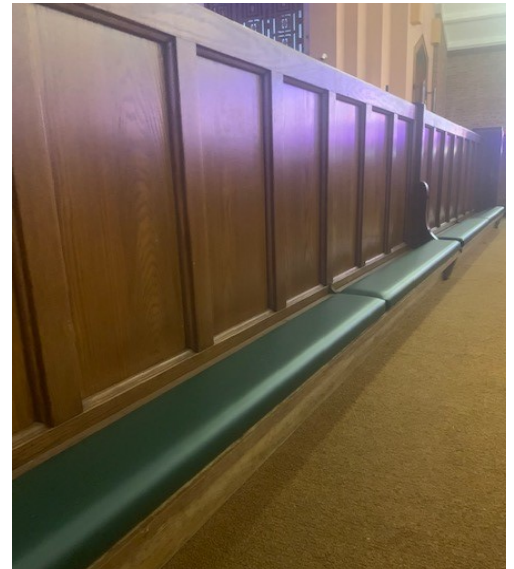

**Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !**

**Adoro Te Devote**

*I am not like Thomas, wounds I cannot see, But can plainly call thee Lord and God as he; Let me to a deeper faith daily nearer move, Daily make me harder hope and dearer love*

St. Thomas the Apostle is widely known as “Doubting Thomas.” After the Resurrection, he did not believe his brother apostles that Jesus Christ rose from the dead. “Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe” proclaimed the apostle. Why the wounds? The wounds were the confirmation that this is the same Jesus that walked, talked, and ate with them for the past three years. The wounds are the permanent signs of God’s infinite love for us.

In the Holy Eucharist, we do not see these tangible wounds. We do not see the pierced side. We do not see the nail marks on his feet or hands. Although we cannot see these wounds, we do not doubt. We know, by committing ourselves completely to the Lord and his word, that Jesus Christ is here among us through this sacrament of love. With solid faith, we do not need to doubt. We do not need to demand a sign of God’s love.

If you do have doubts, there is no need to fear. We all have our Thomas moments. When faced with doubts, we should ask the Lord to increase our faith. Even if we think we have solid faith, we should ask for an increase of faith anyway. The more faith we have, the more we are aware of God’s love in our lives. The more we recognize God’s love in our lives the stronger the drive we have to share that love with our neighbors.

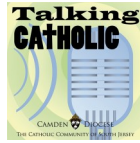

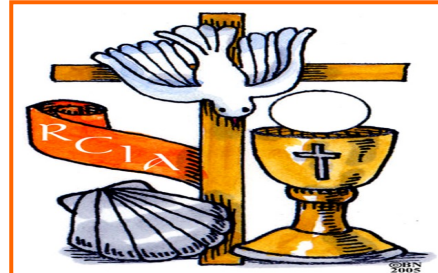

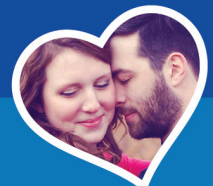
