- ♦ **Hand Sanitizer:** Is available at entrance & exit of the church. We encourage people to bring their own.

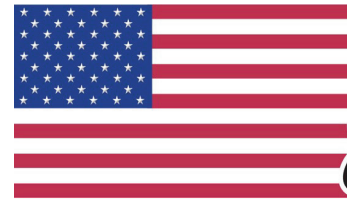

STATEMENT OF THE NEW JERSEY BISHOPS Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society.

Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180).

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).

Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives (communion in the hand, communion under one species, etc.) in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop.

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Adoro Te Devote

Bring the tender tale true of pelican; Bathe me, Jesus Lord, in what thy bosom ran. Blood whereof a single drop has power to win all the world forgiveness of its world of sin

What an odd image! A pelican? Thomas Aquinas makes note of a tale when referring to the pelican. The tradition goes that, when the children of a pelican are starving, the pelican will slice its own breast. The pelican would then feed its young with its own blood. Sound familiar? Jesus Christ, recognizing our starvation of grace, sheds his own blood for us. It is truly a remarkable image to pray about. He makes this tale come true on the cross.

While on the cross, his blood dripped down his weak body. Eventually, his Most Precious Blood dripped down to the soil of the earth. Jesus Christ, by the shedding of his blood, sanctifies and saves the whole world. Through his blood, we see the love God has for the world. Just as the pelican pierces it’s side for its children so does God pierce his side for his children.

We are so blessed that we are able to receive this same blood in the Most Holy Eucharist. Due to Covid-19, we are unable to distribute under both species (the form of bread and wine). When we receive Jesus in the Eucharistic Host, however, we receive both the body and the blood of Christ in its entirety. When we receive Holy Communion, Jesus’ blood flows through our veins. We are connected to Christ spiritually and physically. Let us never forget this privilege that we have.

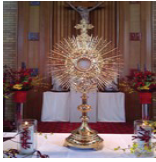
