Dear Parishioner,

Today's readings are quite a challenge. As followers of Christ we are all successors to Jeremiah and the apostles and have a responsibility to share Christ's message with the world.

Each of us as individuals have a prophetic message to share from the Lord. And each of us must in our own way fulfill the calling that God has given to us. In a world and a society that has many Godless acts and immoral actions taking place it is not an easy stance to take since it is always easier to walk with the group than to stand alone.

In 1972 the monks of Weston Priory in Vermont released a song entitled "Wherever You Go". Although this song was based on the Book of Ruth from the Old Testament it can be adapted and interpreted to hear the Lord reminding us that He will be forever at our side as we live our life for Him. Wherever we go and take risks for Him he will be there to see us through. In saying "yes" to our life as Christian disciples, we are doing the will of the Father, the Son and the Spirit. And we are being reminded, do not be afraid for God will be with us.

How will God be calling you this week to be a messenger for Him? How will He ask you to give a prophetic message to the people that you encounter? Will you remember that he is with you at all times? Everywhere that you go?

During the week of July 10th to 14th we will offer a week of service to the youth of the parish who are slated to receive Confirmation in 2018. The week will begin with talks given by members of Cape May County and Diocesan Organizations who work with the needy locally. On one day the students will prepare a hot meal for the homeless at a local outreach center. On two of the days the students will be working the farm in Goshen that supplies food to the Rescue Mission in Atlantic City. And on the last day the students will be working on a project that will hopefully carry through to the surrounding area and some specific local businesses referred to as "Hunger on the Move". We will be sure to keep you posted.

There was a flyer in the bulletin last week requesting some items needed by the Rescue Mission in Atlantic City that are not supplied to them by other means. If you are able to help in any small way please leave your donations in the church next weekend. (If you are unable to help please pray for the Mission and the clients but please do not make any financial donations to the parish for this cause.)

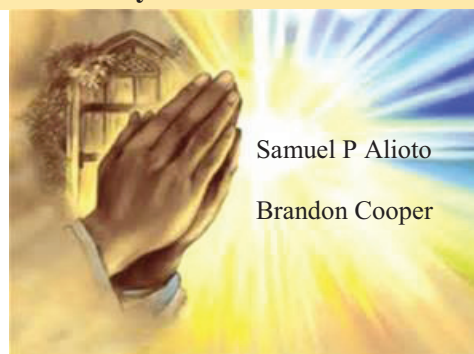

South Jersey Catholic School students set to lose critical funding in 2017-18

Are You a Taxpayer?

Students in Catholic schools save New Jersey taxpayers millions of dollars annually. Each child who leaves a Catholic school and moves to public school costs taxpayers an average \$19,000 a year. So it's in all our best interest to help keep students in our Catholic schools.

Governor Christie has proposed flat or reduced funding for non-public school students in the 2017-18 school year. In his plan, the per-student allotment for bus transportation will remain \$884 – an amount that has not changed in 10 years. Every year, students are forced to leave our schools because of transportation challenges. Also, funding for school nurses and technology will be reduced, and funding for non-public school security will be eliminated altogether.

We are asking for equitable distribution of funds for expenses that affect all students, no matter where they go to school.

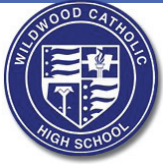

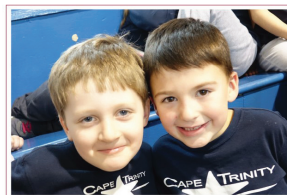

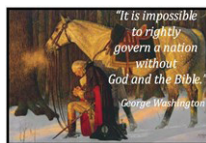
