Letter From Father Yvans Jazon

Dear Parishioners,

I want to use this opportunity to thank everyone who prayed with me and helped me to celebrate my 10th Anniversary. It was such a blessed time which I shall always remember.

This is amazing that the readings in the gospel for this weekend speak about hospitality and being generous as I keep thinking of all your generosity and hospitality to me and my family/friends. Hospitality means acknowledging the presence of God in others and serving Him, especially in those in whom we least expect to find Him. We as a community are to look for the opportunities to be hospitable and, of course, there are plenty of ways of offering hospitality. Yet, we are encouraged to be the face of Jesus in the lives of those God put in our way. Jesus assures his disciples as he assures us that whoever shows hospitality to a brother and to a sister and to the one who is preaching the word of God, they will be blessed. He also instructs us in the gospel of John 13:20 *“Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever receives the one I send receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me”*. As a community of faith, it is always a step forward to heaven when we act Christ-like by helping others to be faithful to their mission. I truly remember that I was stranger to all of you, but it is amazing how God connects us together and I am so blessed to call you my brothers and my sisters. Jesus said to those who *help* the "little ones" and his messengers will be amply rewarded. As followers of Christ we are called to love God, our brothers and sisters by being hospitable, generous, and by expressing charitable acts. This reminds us of our mission to preach, to teach and to do missions for the Lord. When we bear witnesses to God, it may also demand suffering and sacrifices. Yes, it is important to do charitable work to help our brothers and sisters. However, the true gift that is important is the gift of self. Many of us have been giving to so many charitable causes to help people around the world and even in our own diocese and in our own parishes, and these are great ways to share our lives with others because when we give, we need to use our hands, our heart and our mind. The Good News is that the modesty of our circumstances does not limit our potential rewards. We don't have to be a prophet to receive a prophet's reward, we have only to receive a prophet. We don't have to be a great saint to receive a great saint's reward, we have only to show hospitality to such a saint. The smallest gift to the littlest disciple brings a certain reward. Just as God knows and cares about every hair of our heads, so also He knows about our generous acts in behalf of the faithful. Such gifts are counted as gifts to Jesus -- and gifts to Jesus are counted as gifts to the Father. Another bit of Good News is that, as we are engaged in the Lord's work, those who help us are also promised a reward. That is true whether we are clergy or lay people, preachers or janitors. We may not be comfortable being on the receiving end rather than the giving end, but the Lord has ordained that our receiving becomes a means of blessing to the giver.

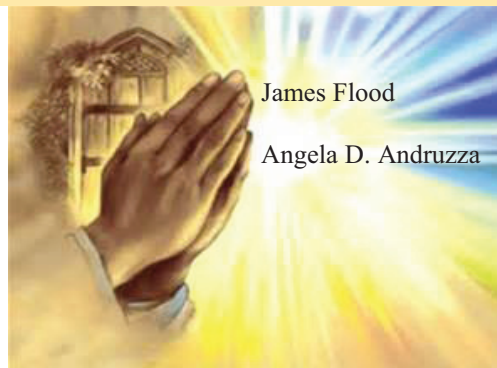

South Jersey Catholic School students set to lose critical funding in 2017-18

Are You a Taxpayer?

Students in Catholic schools save New Jersey taxpayers millions of dollars annually. Each child who leaves a Catholic school and moves to public school costs taxpayers an average \$19,000 a year. So it's in all our best interest to help keep students in our Catholic schools.

Governor Christie has proposed flat or reduced funding for non-public school students in the 2017-18 school year. In his plan, the per-student allotment for bus transportation will remain \$884 – an amount that has not changed in 10 years. Every year, students are forced to leave our schools because of transportation challenges. Also, funding for school nurses and technology will be reduced, and funding for non-public school security will be eliminated altogether.

We are asking for equitable distribution of funds for expenses that affect all students, no matter where they go to school.

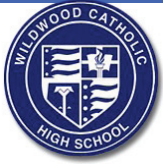
