Dear Parishioner,

I hope you all had a wonderful 4th of July celebration this past week! I joined the Oblates of St. Francis deSales in Cape May for their annual cookout and had a wonderful time with them. As I watched the fireworks my thoughts turned to that Fourth of July in 1826 on the fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the last two surviving founding fathers. At the age of 90, former President John Adams lay on his deathbed looking out his window at the fireworks, on that day he spoke his last words before dying, saying "Thomas Jefferson still survives." However, unbeknownst to him, Jefferson had died five hours earlier at Monticello at the age of 82. These two revolutionaries and Presidents embodied the spirit of our great nation in their love for liberty and country. We give thanks to Almighty God for all the benefits and freedoms we enjoy thanks to those great warriors who risked life and liberty to establish these United States of America!

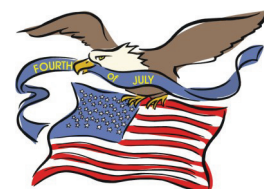

Pilgrims have been walking various routes from all over Europe since 814ad. He will be assisting with various projects here at the parish this summer including our Religious Education Summer Intensive. We are happy to have Tom with us this summer!

And lastly, I would like to welcome Mrs. Mary Vey as our administrative assistant here at the parish. Mary comes to us with a wealth of knowledge and experience in both the business and pastoral ministerial world. She will be a great asset to our parish in so many ways! She has already proven her skills in her service as chair of our parish's Catholic Strong Campaign.

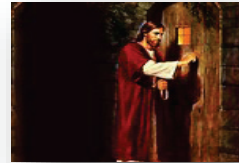

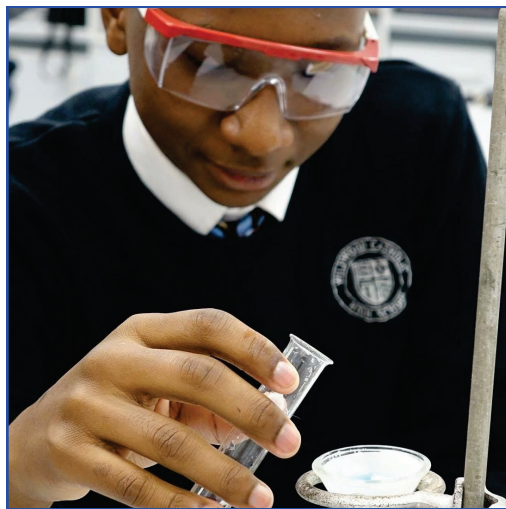

What is the *Catholic Strong* Campaign?

Catholic Strong, the Campaign for the Catholic Community of South Jersey, is an effort to raise a minimum of \$50 million in gifts and pledges. Seventy percent (70%) of all dollars collected up to the parish's goal will be used to support the needs defined by each parish. Every parish in the Diocese has been assigned a financial target to reach in order to meet both the needs of the parish and specific needs of the Diocese, which will be funded with the remaining 30% raised. The needs being addressed through the campaign of both the Diocese and the parish are extraordinary needs beyond those supported on an annual basis by parish offertory or the House of Charity.

Why do we need a major fundraising campaign?

At the time of the mergers and consolidations of parishes in the Diocese, it was believed that the majority of our parishes, because of efficiencies of right-sizing and the sale of property, would become operationally stable and prepared to meet ongoing physical plant and maintenance needs. Unfortunately, as a result of the "great recession" of 2008, many parishes in the Diocese of Camden have been struggling financially. Most are able to meet their day-to-day operational expenses, but few are ready to deal with major physical plant needs. Understanding the challenges that our parishes face, 70% of all funds collected up to the parish goal will go directly to the parish to meet their own unique needs.

Thirty percent (30%) of the funds raised up to the parish's goal will be directed to meet specific needs of the Diocese of Camden that cannot be met by the House of Charity. The Diocese operates with funds provided by the House of Charity – Bishop's Annual Appeal, the assessment revenue provided by parishes, and the income from sources such as investments, rental income and service fees. These operational funds come in and go out every year from the House of Charity to meet the day-to-day operations. There is no surplus.

Since his arrival in the Diocese of Camden, Bishop Sullivan, as part of his strategic plan, has identified a variety of needs to be addressed at the diocesan level. These include increasing the effectiveness of our faith formation and evangelization ministries by matching them to those provided in our individual parishes, coordination of the delivery of social service and social justice services to better serve our parishes, and providing resources identified as essential by the Catholic Schools Commission for building up our Catholic schools. These are needs that go beyond the ability of the House of Charity.
