Message from Father Joseph D. Wallace, Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I write with a heart full of longing to return to our pre-pandemic parish life! We have all been living under the needed restrictions of social distancing these past few months. We here at Notre Dame de la Mer Parish have been attempting to reach out to you and minister to your spiritual needs as best we can during these trying times for us all. I hope you have been experiencing the longing to return to greater community life as a believing family of Disciples of Christ. While all of our ministerial staff has been trying to reach out to you spiritually through live-streaming, phone calls and emails, we long for a time when we will be physically together again, which I pray will come soon with a cure and vaccine.

Our Sunday morning 7 and 8 am Masses, at Fox Park have been well attended. We continue to ask everyone to wear a mask and sit 6 feet apart. You can bring your own lawn chair and I suggest a beach or rain umbrella to keep the sun off. Families are certainly allowed to sit together closer than 6 feet but we ask all others to make sure they are 6 feet apart. We thank the City of Wildwood for this permission to celebrate Mass in the park, as we agree with the health experts who say that outdoor venues are the safest place for large crowds to gather. We will continue to provide our 4:30PM live-streaming Mass on Saturdays, followed by distribution of Holy Communion on the steps of both St. Ann and Assumption churches. We encourage any of our older parishioners or those with any health concerns to continue to watch and receive Holy Communion following the live-stream.

I would like to thank all those who have signed up for parish giving. It is very simple, easy and safe to sign up for this way of giving by going to our website and following the very easy instructions. I also thank those who have been mailing in or dropping off their offerings throughout this pandemic. Mr. Kevin Quinn, parish administrator, will share in greater detail our financial details in a subsequent dear parishioner. But with the diminished summer attendees, who's generous donations helps fuel us financially throughout the year also diminished, we are very grateful for our generous year-round parishioners who continue to faithfully support us. May the Lord bless you for your generosity and sacrifices!

We have been able to save our Catholic tradition of education once again here in Cape May County by your generous support. The birth of our new Wildwood Catholic Academy, a pre-kindergarten to 12th grade school is off to a wonderful start even in spite of this pandemic and all that goes with it. I ask those who have been blessed with the means to sponsor or partially sponsor a student to please contact the school. Your gift of a Catholic education to a student truly in need will be a gift that you give for the rest of this young person's entire life. Our enrollment is looking better and with the announcement that our Catholic schools in the Diocese of Camden opening 5 days a week once school starts, new families are seeing the tuition to be a better alternative to paying for child sitting in schools that will not be opening full time in September.

Know that you are always in our prayers and ever held in my heart! Let us never give in to despair as we are all always spiritually linked to one another in Christ, for "indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord!"

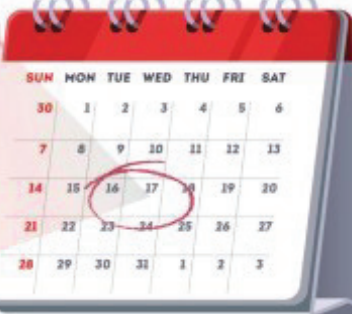

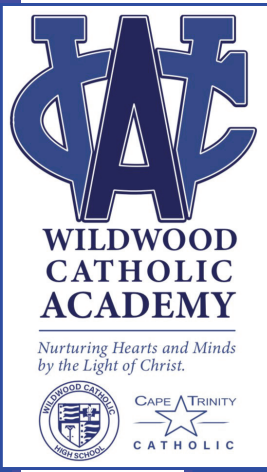

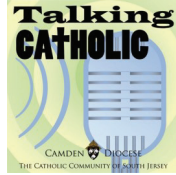

Weekly Readings Reflection

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- The Kingdom of God is a treasure beyond price. Take time to examine your treasures in this life. Make a family treasure box. Have the members of your family place one of their prized treasures in the box. If their treasure cannot be placed in the box, have them write its name on a piece of paper and put that in the box. Talk about those treasures and why they are so meaningful to each person. Sit down around the treasure box. Talk about God's love and the treasure of God's kingdom. Have your family write down some spiritual treasures that they wish to cultivate. Place the notes in the treasure box.
- Enjoy the treasure of family time together. Go on a picnic, go swimming, or do some other family activity you enjoy.
