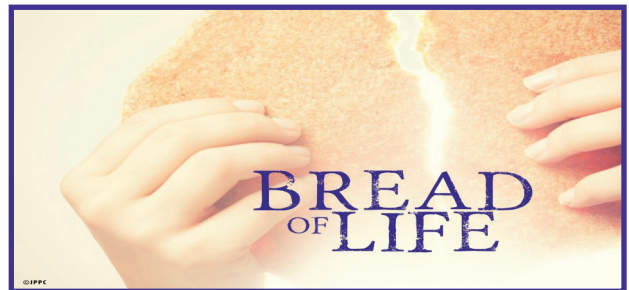

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel Jesus talks about being the Bread of Life. The living bread that came down from heaven so that we may live forever with him. We need Jesus in our lives to survive. Jesus is the nourishment of our souls. Receiving Jesus in the Eucharist helps us to live good moral lives.

One of my favorite things to about being the Catechetical Leader of NDDLDM is teaching the First Holy Communion children about the Eucharist with Ms. Karen Pommer. The look on these children's faces when we talk about the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist is pure awe. Somehow over the years this awe is lost and so too is our FAITH lost in the true sense of the word. The scriptural definition of Faith is the assurance that the things revealed and promised in the Word are true, even though unseen, and gives the believer a conviction that what he expects in faith, will come to pass. The presence of the risen Christ in the Eucharist is an inexhaustible mystery that the Church can never fully explain in words and for this we need our God given Faith. As Catholic's this belief is what makes us different than any other Christian Religion but, when asked, a large percentage of Catholic's believe the Eucharist is just a symbol of Jesus's body. How can this be true? How can we call ourselves Catholic if we do not believe in the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist?

Fr. Mazarella spoke in his homily last week about modern-day miracles of the Eucharist. This reminded me of a recent lesson I taught my Confirmation class. On the last day of class in May I showed them a video of Eucharistic miracles. The children were stunned and couldn't believe it was happening. It is sad for me to think there are parents and other adults out there who do not know these miracles exist. I encourage you today when you leave mass to do a quick Google or YouTube search on Eucharistic Miracles and you too can be stunned and in awe of the true power of God.

These miracles can renew and restore your faith and with this renewed faith I implore you to go out and spread his good news to the world.

Reading I: 1 Kings 19:4-8

The angel of the Lord came back to him.

- Elijah, discouraged and fearing for his life, flees into the desert and prays for death.
- God's answer to his prayer echoes the Exodus and desert experience of Israel.
- Though he is discouraged and desperate when he flees into the desert, Elijah is transformed by the bread and water sent from God.

Reading II: Ephesians 4:30-5:2

Live in love.

- Today's passage describes the undeniable love that Christ has shown.
- Paul reminds the Ephesians that they share in new life with God.
- Christ gave his life for love of us; we must in turn show love to our neighbor.

Gospel: John 6:41-51

No one can come to me unless my Father draws him or her.

- Those who hear Jesus describe himself as "bread from heaven", murmur about Jesus being the Bread of Life.
- This echoes Israel murmuring in the desert about food and water and leadership.
- The difference between manna and Jesus is that those who ate the manna died, but those who eat the Bread of Life will live forever.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Jesus is our living bread. For what do you hunger? How can Jesus fill that hunger?
- Talk about ways to nourish your family life. What food does your family need for the journey of life? Write down a nutrition plan for your family. A standard nutrition plan may include more fruits and vegetables. This alternative family plan may include more and better communication. Post the results somewhere so that everyone can see them and can follow the plan.
- Go on a family picnic. Bring food and a Bible for nourishment. Read from the Gospel of John, 6:41-51. Talk about what nourishes your life.
- Arrange to visit someone in your parish who is home-bound and cannot attend the Eucharist.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Apollinaris, Bishop and martyr

Apollinaris is said to be a native of Antioch and a follower of Saint Peter. He is said to have traveled with Saint Peter from Antioch where, sometime later, Peter ordained him as bishop and sent him to Ravenna. Soon after his arrival, Apollinaris performed his first miracle when a Centurion asked him to cure his son who was blind. When Apollinaris made the sign of the cross on the boy's eyes, his sight was instantly restored. Local secular leaders, seeing the success that Apollinaris was having, aroused the people against him and caused him to be beaten to near death and left on the seashore. Christians in his community cared for him and nursed him back to health.

Sometime later, during the reign of the emperor Vespasian, Apollinaris was again arrested. This time he was stretched on a rack and plunged into boiling oil. When he survived this treatment, he was exiled to Illyria (present day Croatia) across the Adriatic Sea.

In his exile, Apollinaris evangelized many of the people of Illyria until, when an oracle ceased speaking, the pagans again beat him and put him on a ship returning to Italy. Soon he was seized and beaten again. He is said to have died from this treatment in the year 79AD.

Saint Apollinaris is the patron of those suffering from gout and epilepsy.

Few of us have faith as strong as Apollinaris and might break down in the face of the trials that he faced, but God is always there for us.

Do you pray often that God will give you the strength to cope with the trials that you face?

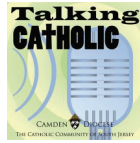

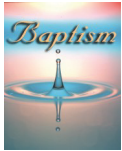

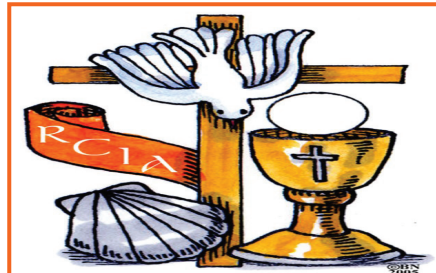
