## Letter From AnnaMae Muryasz

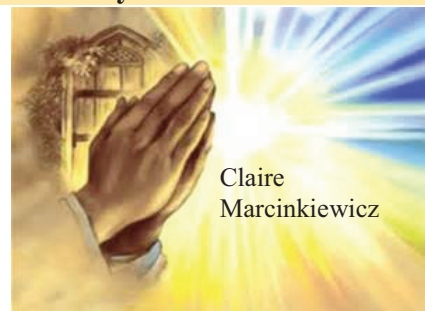

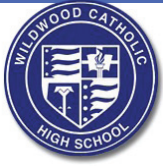
