Dear Parishioners,

The biblical readings of this Sunday announce to us a good news: the salvation of God is offered to all; it is not limited only to believers. Prophet Isaiah in the first reading helps us to understand the salvific plan of God for humanity. The message talks about how God opens his heart to all regarding race and nation. All those who honor God and are attracted to his words find that by honoring him and becoming his servants they'll be led to a Holy Mountain which is described in the bible as a place of special encounter with God. His message should be announced and we have to take appropriate efforts to allow all those who do not have opportunities to experience God's grace and mercy to listen to it. As stewards of his Church, Jesus wants to use us Christians to reach out to others by inviting our friends who might need to hear the word of God or family members who might be interested in opening his or her heart to the Lord. This is what Pope Francis reminds us when he asks us to open our doors to meet those who are far, even in the "peripheries". The Word of God must be announced to all, says Pope Francis. As a family of faith, we are called to pray for one another and to intercede before God on behalf of our brothers and sisters. "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples". With this wonderful word, God invites us to be part of this house where we can call ourselves a family of faith.

In the Gospel story, Jesus demonstrates that salvation was meant for the Gentiles as well as for the Jews by healing the daughter of a Gentile woman as a reward for her strong Faith. Therefore, Jesus shows that God's mercy and love are available to all who call out to Him with Faith. As Christians we can be the voice of those who do not have the possibility to call upon God for mercy. And yet, this Canaanite woman is upright, humble, ready, humorous, and above all, has an astonishing faith that made Jesus admire her. She came to Jesus with a short prayer "Lord, help me". The reply statement of Jesus does not compare Children to the dogs but this is an analogy to demonstrate the value of faith and Jesus wants to teach that woman that graces and blessings are not to be wasted but reserved to those who believe in God. "She said "Please Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters". This is an extraordinary lesson for all of us who are disciples of Christ. We have to understand the value of our faith and continue to keep it precious. The faith of the Canaanite woman is a great example of intercessory prayer which we do every day at mass or when we give mass intention for our friends or family members. Like the Canaanite woman, we have great faith in the healing power of our God. When everything seems desperately over, we still have hope in the everlasting love and mercy of Jesus. Like the Canaanite woman, we beseech Jesus: "Have mercy on us, have mercy on our world which is tormented by injustice, violence and misery. Jesus continues to send us to the world as testimonies of his love to all those who are wounded emotionally or spiritually. He sends us to heal, to console and to spread his love. The biblical texts of this Sunday invite us to change our gaze on those who have not yet fully accepted Jesus as their savior, for we know Jesus' love is universal and limitless.

May God continue to open our hearts to the everlasting love of Jesus, as we ask him to help us to open our hearts to those who are culturally different and spiritually not at the same level than us, and may we continue to help them experience the fraternal and communal love of Christ.
