Dear parishioners,

The theme of the Readings for today is the virtue of humility. Jesus challenges us in today's gospel to be aware that all who exalt themselves will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

So what is humility? Unfortunately, we often tend to confuse humility with modesty or shyness, which are similar. While modesty and shyness are more about concern with outward appearances or speech, humility is a spiritual or internal virtue.

You see, Humility recognizes that all we are and all we have are gifts from God even though we might have worked hard to acquire them. He gave us time, talents or opportunity to acquire them. There is no such thing as a "self-made" man or woman.

In fact, our recognition of God's gifts should cause us to help those less fortunate. The writer of Sirach is giving wise advice when he encourages all mankind to be humble, because boasting and superiority have no place in the kingdom of God. You see, the message is straight-forward and needs little interpretation and yet, modern society seems to think that humility is only for the meek or weak.

In reality, my friends, it takes a strong character and a strong sense of God in one's life to be truly humble.

My friends, our Gospel reading today is a lesson in humility and probably the clearest statement from Jesus on the subject, "For everyone who exalts himself shall be humbled and he who humbles himself shall be exalted," in the eyes of God.

Note that the last part of this reading, with reference to inviting the poor, the lame and the blind to dinner, is not so much a directive, but rather an exaggeration of the point of observing the virtue of humility to benefit those less fortunate.

Again, we must try to understand the spiritual (or Biblical) meaning of humility.

Truth be told, it does not mean to demean or belittle oneself, but instead to recognize who we are in the eyes of God and what God is in our life and then recognizing that all of our possessions, talents and good qualities are God's gifts to us. What we do with them is our gift to God.

Something to think about during your prayer time this week!

My friends, often taking the "last place" is a matter of changing our attitude rather than our physical place, a question of generosity rather than status. God's banquet table includes places of honor for every hurting, confused soul — saint and sinner, scholar and laborer, billionaire and shift worker.

**The spirit of humility** as taught by Jesus is the realization that we share with every human being the dignity of being made in the image and likeness of God; therefore, Christ-like humility is the ability to see one another as God sees us and to rejoice in being ministers to one another in the joys and struggles we all experience.

May God our Father give you grace and peace!

## Readings of the Week

**Reading I:** [Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29](#)

*Conduct your affairs with humility.*

- Today's first reading gives us the wisdom of Ben Sira, a second-century Jerusalem sage.
- Because of the upper-class situation of the sage and his students, today's lesson on humility is dramatic.
- The final verses introduce a favorite subject of Ben Sira, the giving of alms.

**Reading II:** [Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a](#)

*You have drawn near to the city of the living God.*

- In today's reading from Hebrews the image of the Israelites at Mount Sinai is colored with details from the book of Exodus and other Old Testament passages.
- The gloomy and fearful aspects of the old covenant experience are emphasized in contrast to the picture of Mount Zion.
- Christians do not have to live in fear of imitating the failures of certain figures in the history of salvation, for they have the advantage of the person of Jesus, who sealed the new covenant in his own blood.

**Gospel:** [Luke 14:1, 7-14](#)

*Whoever exalts self shall be humbled and whoever humbles self will be exalted.*

- In today's Gospel, Luke presents a scene with Jesus in the home of a Pharisee.
- Jesus addresses the guests in the house with a parable that warns against self-exaltation. This lesson comes soon after the disciples were reprimanded by Jesus for vying for position.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Invite someone to dinner who doesn't get out very much or who is alone. Remind the family that anyone who comes to your home is your guest and is to be welcomed as Jesus would be welcomed.
- Talk about pride and humility with your family. Is it dangerous to exaggerate your own importance? Does anyone know someone who does that? Why do we sometimes try to appear to be what we are not? Why do we sometimes fail to recognize our own worth? Discuss what today's Gospel teaches about pride and humility. Explain that true humility is knowing our own worth but also knowing the worth of others.
