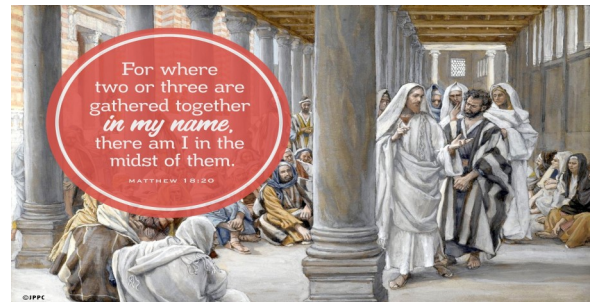

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I: Ezekiel 33:7-9

*The wicked will not prosper.*

- Ezekiel is commissioned as a sentinel, with responsibility to warn God's people of impending danger.
- God's message was sent to the people through the prophet Ezekiel.
- The prophet must listen to God and deliver God's message and the people, for their own safety, must listen to the prophet and hear in the prophet's words the voice of God.

### Reading II: Romans 13:8-10

*Whoever loves his or her neighbor, fulfills the law.*

- The passage from the Letter to the Romans describes the unity demanded of Christians.
- Love is the fulfillment of the Law.
- The whole Law, in Hebrew Scriptures and in the New Testament, is summed up in love of neighbor and love of God.

### Gospel: Matthew 18:15-20

*When you join yourselves together in faith, I am with you.*

- The Gospel passage from Matthew contains practical advice for dealing with disagreements within the community and the theological foundation for this advice.
- The meaning of "binding and loosing" is the power of admission and excommunication.
- Today's passage gives the theological reason for such power. Where two or three are gathered together in unity, whether in prayer or deliberation, they will be heard by God.

## Family Reflection Corner

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- How can you help the members of your family grow in faith? As a family, make a list of ways you can make your home a better reflection of God's love.
- Jesus said that when two or more people come together in his name — he will be there. To help your family experience the power of praying together, pray the Lord's Prayer aloud in unison. Pause for a moment of silence. Invite family members to silently pray for one another. Close by thanking God for the gifts of faith and family.
- Talk with your family about ways to correct someone and still stay friends. In today's Gospel Jesus suggested: 1. Talk with the person yourself. 2. Talk with the person with one or two others. 3. Tell someone in charge.

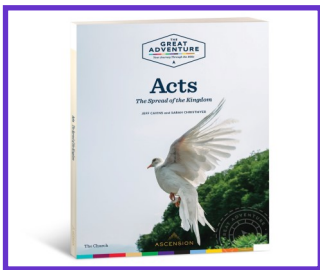

### IMPORTANT CHANGE AND ANNOUNCEMENT!

The Bishop's office in the Diocese of Camden announced this past spring that all parishes in the Diocese will no longer be able to have more than one Saturday evening mass, even if you are a parish with more than one church. The shore communities with permission from the Bishop are only allowed to have an additional Saturday Mass in the summer season. See decree.

Following the new directive as we must, and through consultation with the Parish Council, it was decided that we will be having one Saturday Mass at 4:30pm which will be held at St Ann Church beginning on Saturday October 7th. There will not be a Saturday Mass at the Church of the Assumption after September 30 until Memorial Day weekend beginning again on May 25th and lasting through the summer months.

We will continue to have Daily Mass, Sunday 8:30AM Mass and other celebrations including Confirmation and the Easter Triduum at Assumption Church.

This decision was not made arbitrarily. Many factors were taken into consideration when deciding which church would be used for winter Masses.

1. St Ann is more centrally located on the island
2. St Ann has adequate parking for Mass
3. It is more cost efficient to heat St Ann than Assumption
4. The numbers for the last year support more people attending St Ann than Assumption

#### DECRETE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN

In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesial community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharistic Sacramentum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:

1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest, the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.

This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.
