Message from Fr. Joseph Wallace, Pastor

Dear Parishioner,

It is so good to be back inside our beautiful churches as we see some light at the end of the coronavirus tunnel we are traveling through! The pandemic has changed all of our lives in many ways. Our outdoor Sunday Masses at Fox Park were the safest means of gathering as a worshipping community during the summer months with so many visitors coming from so many different parts of our area. We hope to be able to offer an early morning Mass next summer at the park, as so many have remarked on how much they enjoyed the outdoor venue. I would like to thank our parish staff and a number of volunteers who so generously gave of their time throughout the summer at our outdoor Masses setting up and breaking down. I would like to thank the City of Wildwood for allowing us to use the park for Masses this summer.

We have opened our new Wildwood Catholic Academy, the first pre-K to 12th academy in our Diocesan history. Much work went into first, saving Catholic education in Cape May County, by an army of people under the inspiration of Carole Pantalone and Joe Bogle, workers and donors, who laid the foundation for our new Academy! I thank them one and all! I would also like to thank our new Academy's administration and faculty for readying the building for the opening of school by putting into place all the needed safe school standards complying with executive orders in the state of New Jersey as well as guidelines from the New Jersey Department of Education and Department of Health. Our school will be open every day, and we have a remote learning option available for families who are not ready to be back in the school building yet. Please let any of your friends or family know that we still have some spots available in some grades for all day in school education in the Catholic tradition.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank Sr. Sheila Murphy who retired earlier this summer for her many years of dedicated service to both St. Ann and Cape Trinity Catholic schools. She was instrumental in the opening and then the closure of Cape Trinity Catholic, and we thank her for her many years of dedicated service to Catholic education. We would also like to thank the Sisters of St. Joseph who have served in this area from the beginning of Catholic education down here in Cape May County. Sr. Sheila was the last of many dedicated Sisters of St. Joseph who have served our parish for many years. We wish Sister Sheila well in her retirement and her new ministerial endeavors.

Know that I am ever grateful for your generosity over these past six months of pandemic and separation from our beloved church buildings. As I'm sure you are aware that we are down approximately 50% in donations over the past summer. We tried to reach out virtually as much as possible and thank you for your patience with our technical learning curve! Soon we will have a more consistent and professional live-streaming system in both our church buildings.

Know also that you and your families are in my prayers during this difficult time in human history.

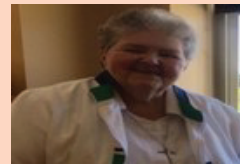

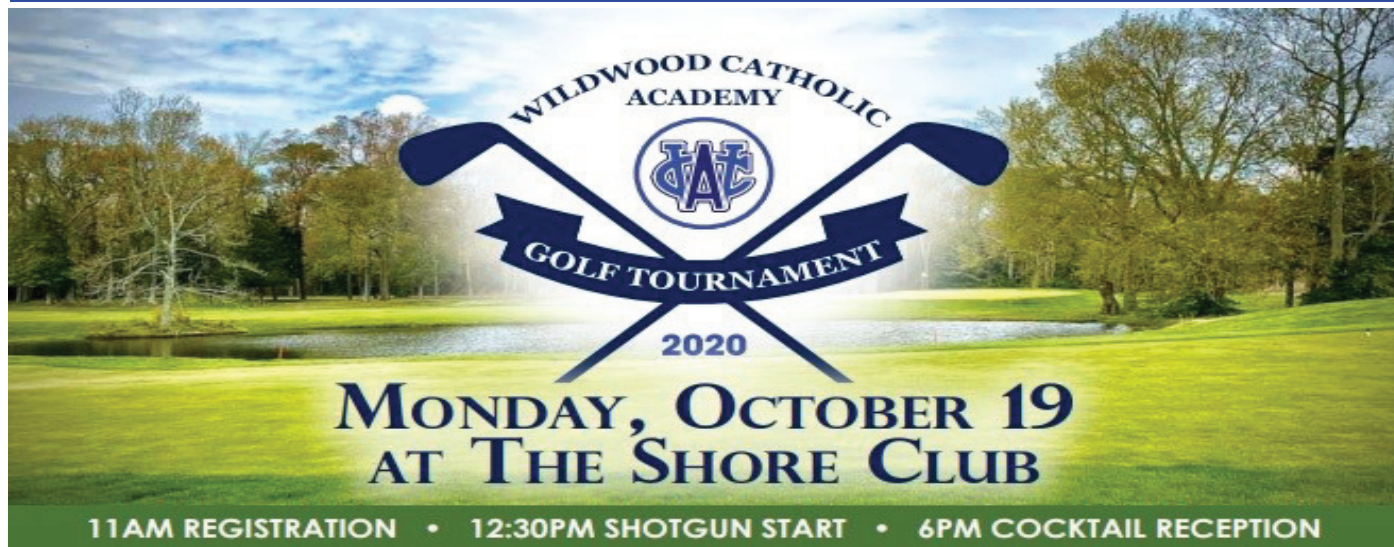

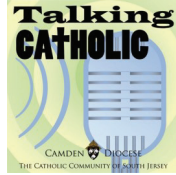

Family Reflection Corner

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Remind family members that forgiving oneself for past mistakes is just as important as forgiving others. Have family members pause and consider whether they are withholding forgiveness of themselves. They should write the situation down then tear it into small pieces and throw it in the trashcan. Discuss what it feels like to really forgive oneself. Remind them that if someone hurts them and they forgive that person, is it okay for the person forgiven to continue holding on to the mistake long after being forgiven? Then wouldn't God be concerned that he has forgiven us but we can't forgive ourselves?
- Consider stories or movies where one of the characters seeks vengeance. What was the outcome of this story? Consider also stories or movies where one of the characters is humble and forgiving. What was the outcome of this story? Discuss the natural consequences of humility.

Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

What is the collection and why do we bring it up to the altar during the offertory?

The collection is what helps function the financial aspects of the parish. This goes toward many parish needs. Just as a regular family needs money to survive, so does the parish family need money to survive. The collection helps pay for utility bills, insurance, salaries for the staff, our Catholic schools and all the other line items you see in our annual financial reports. Although there is the business aspect of the weekly collection, there are also spiritual aspects of giving a weekly donation to your parish family.

As a parish community, we give our weekly donation to show our own gratitude to God. The Lord has given us many blessings and graces in our lives such as our parents, children, homes, food, and jobs. By giving a little portion of our weekly finances, we are able to show God that we are truly thankful for what he has given us. It is through our weekly pay we are able to support our families, pay our bills, buy our food. By giving a small portion of that treasure, we show our thanksgiving to the Lord. For Scripture tells us:

"You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God." 2 Corinthians 9:11

The reason the money is brought up to the altar with the bread and the wine during the offertory is to symbolize our own personal sacrifice to the Father. Every Mass is offered to God the Father through Jesus Christ. The priest, by his ordination, is able to act *in persona Christi* (the person of Christ) thus allowing him to offer the bread and the wine (which will then become the Body and Blood of Christ). This then leaves us to ask the question "what can/did I offer?" You offered your own personal pay. Therefore, it would be fitting that your gifts should be brought up with the gifts of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.
