Dear Parishioners,

Today our story develops at a banquet. In the first reading and gospel we read about a banquet that symbolizes the blessings God has in store for His People. The blessings he also has in store for each of us. In the second reading, Paul tries not to depend on material things, but trusts in the Lord for what he needs; this was hard for Paul to accomplish. So what about us? Are we able to trust? Are we able to let God be in control of our lives and in the driver's seat?

Pope Francis has become the Pope of the people and in turn the Pope who has taken on the simple ways of the people. From the very days when he was first named the Pope, he has insisted on continuing to do the things that he did as a cardinal in his home country of Argentina. He maintained he would pay for his room used during the Conclave as he had always done. Pope Francis was and is the same simple man of God everyone has grown to Love.

Jorge Bergoglio sets the way for all of us to follow. Although he has had the ability to ride in style he chooses to ride the bus with the others on his way to a retreat and he uses a small car given to him to travel about Rome rather than a lavish one. Pope Francis says mass each morning in the chapel of the residence of St. Martha in the Vatican for the ordinary individual to share in the mass and be present without an appointment. As an elderly woman gets excited upon the Pope's approach and drops her handbag, he bends down and picks it up and returns it to her. Nothing is too little or too simple for him to do when he realizes he is doing it for the Lord. He has tried to teach that no matter how hard the outward circumstances are for individuals in their lives they have the capacity to remain inwardly at peace with the Lord. We are all able to hold on to the hope of everlasting life.

As in the gospel the heavenly wedding banquet is open to all. God sends his messengers out to scour the highways and byways in order to fill his house with guests. It is a comforting thought that God wants us to be saved, even more than we do ourselves.

On the other hand there is a special wedding garment that must be worn. This might refer primarily to community spirit, an ability to share our well-being with other people, in the presence of God. Our wedding garment is therefore being woven daily, by the quality of our interaction with others. In this sense, we hold tomorrow in our own hands, as with the help of God's grace we build our own eternal future.

May the Lord bless each of you as you weave your garments for the future!

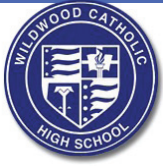

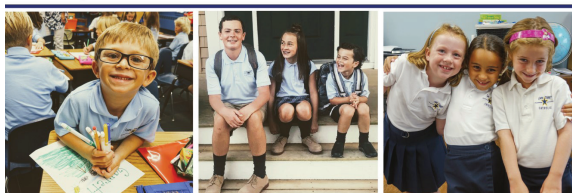
