Dear Parishioner,

I would like to share with you an upcoming event that has been in process for many years here in the United States known as Encuentro. Encuentro is the Spanish word for encounter. Diocesan leaders from around the country are gearing up for the V (fifth) Encuentro, a multi-year, multi-stage effort to get input from Hispanic Catholics about their needs and challenges, as well as possible solutions. Here in the Diocese of Camden a gathering will take place on Saturday, October 28th, that will bring leaders from the Hispanic community here in South Jersey in a diocesan Encuentro. Fr. Cesar and I will be joining a contingent of parishioners from our Hispanic wing of our parish family to participate in this national encounter.

Over a million Catholics are anticipated to participate in this national gathering called for by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. The Bishops are hoping to hear from young adults who are the children and grandchildren of immigrants about how the Church can help them become leaders in Hispanic ministry. The fifth Encuentro has the theme of “Missionary Disciples: Witnesses of God’s Love.” Parishes with Hispanic ministries, like our own, are called to form their own leadership teams and have five weeks of consultation on what would help their people become missionary disciples. After that, each parish will hold its own Encuentro session.

I have had the pleasure to meet with leadership from our Hispanic parish members on a number of occasions and have heard their desire to have opportunities to gather with the wider parish family in prayer and fellowship. We will be working on fostering opportunities for such encounters in the future. Fr. Cesar is going on pilgrimage to Mexico City to visit the shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The basilica he is visiting and that I visited around five years ago is the most visited Roman Catholic pilgrimage site in the world. It is here that Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego four times in 1531, asked him to build a church on that sacred spot and gave him an image of herself upon his cloak. That image now is enshrined in the basilica. Fr. Cesar will bring back with him an image of Our Lady of Guadalupe to hang in St. Ann Church. St. John XXIII invoked and proclaimed her “Mother of the Americas” in 1961. We are happy to soon have her blessed image in our church to remind us of our unity in her protective care.

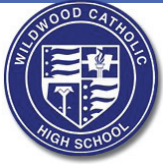
