Message From Jon Delgado, Director of Music and Liturgy

Dear Parishioners,

As the season of autumn is moving right along ever so quickly, so is our liturgical calendar with today being the Thirtieth Sunday in ordinary time. This coming Thursday, November 1st is All Saint's Day, a holy day of obligation which is often overshadowed by the Halloween Holiday the day before. On this feast day, the Church honors all the saints, those who were towering figures, as well as, the humble saints whose names are known to few or to none who now rejoice in God's Presence. November 2nd is the commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Soul's Day) in which the church prays for all who have died. As we remember and pray for our loved ones who have gone before us we also realize the reality that we ourselves one day must die as well.

Next Sunday, November 4th at Saint Ann church during the 10:30am Mass we will remember all the faithfully departed as well as paying special tribute and offering prayers to those who have passed away from our parish family within this past year. All are invited to bring a picture of a deceased loved one to place on the steps of the altar before Mass begins.

Four weeks from this Sunday we will end another Liturgical Year with the Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe and begin a new Liturgical Year with the First Sunday of Advent. Knowing that Advent is just around the corner our Music Ministry has already begun preparations for our first ever, parish produced, Christmas Concert entitled "A Prelude to Christmas" to be held on Sunday, December 16th, 6:00pm at Saint Ann Church. Our Adult, Contemporary and Children's Choirs will all be performing and accompanied by a professional Orchestra which will lead to the concert's finale, the story of the Holy Nativity which will be brought to life in the Sanctuary by the youth of our parish and from all the church communities on the island. Please mark your calendars for this very special night for our parish. More details will follow in the weeks to come. For now let us keep enjoying this autumn season and Ordinary Time in the church. I wish you a Happy Halloween, a Holy All Saint's Day and a prayerful All Soul's Day.


