Eucharistic Revival

Hello brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

The Kingdom is where the King is!

Last month we left off with a beautiful word Luke and Matthew used in their Gospels, in the Lord's prayer, referring to the Eucharist. They used a high-powered word, in Greek called *Epiousios*, which means "super substantial"

Let us begin this month, as we celebrate and rejoice, that we have for our human consumption the spiritual nourishment, power and the glory of this "super substantial" bread.

In this Letter, we will see that the Eucharist was always part God's plan. John's Gospel is only one place describing the Eucharist but in fact in the Torah, the Old Testament screams about it. The plan for the Eucharist was God's plan from the beginning. As written in Genesis, in the Garden of Eden, God knew the importance of our human experience and need for food consumption to be in Communion with Him. He wanted Adam and Eve to eat from the Tree of Life.

Then again, the bread of life is referenced in Genesis 14:18, when Abram defeated four of five kings and rescued Lot, his nephew. Because of this victory, Melchizedek, the king of Salem, brought forth bread and wine to celebrate Abram's victory. Know that Melchizedek, one of the most mysterious figures in the bible, who is the priest forever, of the Most High God. Make no mistake, the message is that bread and wine is being associated and established with the Most High God.

Again, in Genesis 22, When Abraham was going to offer his only begotten son, to the Lord, he was spared and in place offered the roasted flesh of a ram. There is a direct correlation between Abraham's only son being offered and Jesus, the only begotten Son of God, whose flesh was given for us.

Exodus 16 refers to the bread of life God provides the Jewish people, in the mornings, as they flee from Egypt. Manna, "this is the bread the Lord has given you to eat". Moses placed a vessel of it in the Arc of the Covenant along with Aaron's staff and the two stone tablets, for all generations to know God has nourished us. (Numbers 17).

The Bible's Old and New Testament laid out a blueprint for the Eucharist! It shows us it was God's plan. And Jesus fulfilled it!

Read some of these versus. You will be invigorated by Jesus' gift of the Eucharist. Partake in it. Speak to it! Defend it!

When we have the Eucharist at daily Mass and the Eucharist exposed in Adoration, we have the gift of eternal life given to us from the beginning of mankind and fulfilled by Jesus' crucifixion. When we partake, we become part of it.

How so? The Kingdom is where the King is, and the Eucharist is the King, therefore we are in the Kingdom of Heaven when we sit in Adoration and when the Holy Spirit through the priest in *Persona Christi*, transubstantiates bread and wine into the precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, our Lord Jesus Christ.

Reading I: Exodus 22:20-26

Take care to be just, especially to widows and the poor.

- Exodus 20-23 consists primarily of laws.
- Today's passage reminds the Israelites to care for the poor and vulnerable in their midst.
- Any mistreatment of the vulnerable people in the society would be interpreted as a direct affront to God.

Reading II: 1 Thessalonians 1:5c-10

Your faith is an example for others.

- Paul's thanksgiving for the faith of the Thessalonians continues in today's passage.
- The Thessalonians have endured with joy the suffering brought by faithfulness to God's Law.
- As a result, they have become, in their turn, models of faith for the rest of the Near East.

Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

The great commandment.

- The discussion of the Law in today's Gospel is one of the four conflict stories in this section of Matthew.
- A scribe attempts to trap Jesus with the question: "What is the greatest commandment of the Law"?
- Jesus answers by quoting two passages from the Hebrew Scriptures: the command to love God from Deuteronomy 6:5, and the command to love their neighbor from Leviticus 19:18.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

- God asks us to love our neighbor. As a family, investigate the treatment of refugees or other immigrants in your community. What difficulties do they experience? Talk about what you as a family can do to help.
- Collect and write down family stories about your ancestors who first came to this country. What do their experiences teach us about the way we should treat others?
- We show our love for God by imitating God's compassion in caring for those who are poor. Use this time to evaluate your family's concern for those who are poor in your community. Remind your family that you also need to be aware of the sufferings of those who are poor throughout the world. Gather together as a family, and vote on a family project to help alleviate suffering in your community or in the world.

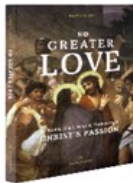

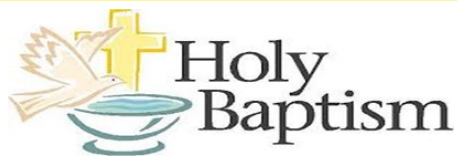
