Letter From Father Yvans Jazon

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I want to start with a story of Polycarp, who was the fifth century bishop of Smyrna, was arrested and brought before the Roman authorities. He was told if he cursed Christ, he would be released. He replied, "Eighty-six years have I served Him, and He has done me no wrong; how then can I blaspheme my King Jesus Christ who saved me?" The Roman officer replied, "Unless you change your mind, I will have you burnt." But Polycarp said, "You threaten a fire that burns for an hour, and after a while is quenched; for you are ignorant of the judgment to come and of everlasting punishment reserved for the ungodly. Do what you wish."

The gospel for this great feast presents us Christ the King as reigning, not from a throne, but from the gibbet of the cross. Like the "suffering servant" of Isaiah (53:3), He is despised and rejected, as the bystanders ridicule the crucified King, challenging Him to prove His Kingship by coming down from the cross. The Gospel also tells of the criminal crucified beside Jesus who recognized Him as a Savior King and asked Jesus to remember him when Jesus entered His kingdom. Jesus promised the good thief that he would be with Him that day in Paradise. Tradition remembers the criminal on Jesus' right side as "the good thief" who repented of his sins at the last moment, though Mark and Matthew call him a "revolutionary." Although the Romans intended the inscription on the cross, "This is the King of the Jews," to be ironic, it reflected the popular Jewish speculations about Jesus' possible identity as the Messiah of Israel. For Luke and other early Christians that title was correct, since the Kingship of Jesus was made manifest most perfectly in his suffering and death on the cross, followed by His Resurrection on the third day, as He had foretold.

Jesus, the King, needs us Catholic Christians as convinced apostles prepared and ready to fight through prayer, and accepting willingly the sufferings that come our way and offering them to God with Jesus, our King, in reparation for our sins and the sins of the world, and finally by living lives of loving humble service, using our gifts generously for all. The battlefield is the home, the school, the work place, the neighborhood, and the parish. These provide new and exciting challenges, new opportunities for us to do, ourselves, what is right and to live out the truth of Jesus Christ our King, neither compromising with sin nor passing judgment on the motives or guilt of any of our brothers and sisters, but loving and praying for all of us. To ensure that Jesus is always the King of our hearts, we need to make a great commitment to Him and to back that commitment with the necessary sacrifices, conviction, hard work and daily serious prayer.

The Solemnity of Christ the King is not just the conclusion of the Church year. It is also a summary of our lives as Christians. On this great Feast, let us resolve to give Christ the central place in our lives and to obey His commandment of love by sharing our blessings with all his needy children. Let us conclude the Church year by asking the Lord to help us serve the King of Kings as He presents Himself in those reaching out to us. "To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His Blood and made us a Kingdom, priests for His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen" (Revelation 1:5b-6). Christus vincit! Christus regnat! Christus imperat! Christ conquers! Christ rules! Christ reigns!

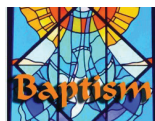
Sacraments

Pre-Baptismal Classes: As the primary educators of their child, the parents/guardians and godparents have the most important influence on the faith development of children and parishes must provide catechesis for them before their child is baptized. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish offers six Baptism Preparation Classes throughout the year. It is important for the expectant parents/guardians to arrange to attend a session *5 months before the birth and Baptism* of the child. Contact the parish offices for more information. **The next class is scheduled for Saturday, January 21, 2017, from 9:30 to 11:00 AM.**

Funerals: To be arranged with a priest and funeral director.

Sacrament of the Sick: Anytime

Marriage: Arrangements should be made one year in advance and prior to making reception plans.



Notre Dame de la Mer Baptism

Baptism is celebrated after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday of each month. In the months of March, June, September and December each year Baptism will also be celebrated during the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Second Sunday of the month. Please check the parish website for a list of the baptism dates for next year.

It is also suggested that if you will be celebrating the sacrament of Baptism in the near future and need to attend a baptismal preparation class that you look ahead and attend the class before your child is born. In the same way that you prepare for the birth of your child with clothing and furniture and a new room you need to prepare for your child in the faith by attending the baptismal preparation class and selecting appropriate godparents who can help you with your child's growth in the faith.
