Campaign Objectives

This \$750,000 campaign will build upon the strong legacy of the Notre Dame de la Mer community, so it can continue meeting the needs of parishioners and students for many generations to come.

The campaign objectives will elevate our facilities to better align with the dignity and excellence of the spiritual care and formation we provide. Objectives with estimated individual cost include:

Phase I: Exterior Roof Replacement – \$190,000 (currently underway)

Phase II: Interior Ceiling & Wall Repair – \$70,000

Total St. Ann Estimate: \$260,000

Replace HVAC System

Phase I: Boiler Replacement – \$95,000

Phase II: 20 Ton Split System (Flanking Altar) – \$184,400

Phase III: 15 Ton Split System (Choir loft) – \$170,600

Retrofit Pendant Lights

Phase I: Completed – Retrofitted Four Lights

Phase II: Retrofit Remaining 20 lights – \$36,000

Phase III: Repair of Choir loft Electric – \$4,000

Total Assumption Estimate: \$490,000

From Fr. Soprano Retired Pastor

Jesus said, “Do this in memory of me.” Today, at Mass we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. At Mass, we remember all that Jesus did for us. But, this feast does more than remember, we are actually connected with the past, and Christ is present in His Risen Form. We may not be able to see Him with our eyes, but we believe in Him by faith. Our faith is strengthened when we accept something as true because of what someone told us. We hear Jesus say in the Gospel, “the bread that I will give is my flesh,” The same words He spoke at the Last Supper are what we hear at every Mass. “This is my body; this is my blood.” Because we believe Jesus spoke truth and with unique power, we believe what he said.

A recent report suggests a very high percentage of young people believe in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, but a much lower percentage say they believe the attendance at Mass each week is not necessary. We understand we need to eat regularly to maintain good health. I think it’s the same with Eucharist. You can’t starve yourself from Jesus and stay strong in body and in faith.

We have recently celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation with 29 new adult Catholics. Bishops Williams spoke to them and, I repeat here, let the spirit of God help them, and all of us with the gift God gives us in Jesus, and He in sending the Holy Spirit to keep us feeding our souls with His presence and discovering over and over what gifts He wants us to share with other parishioners and neighbors while we keep repeating over and over:

“Do this in Memory of Me”

And with all that it truly means. Never take Jesus for granted!

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a - One does not live by bread alone but by the Word of God.

◆ Moses reminded the Israelites that God has taken care of them in the desert and they should trust him. Moses also reminded them that everything they have comes from God and that Manna sustained them as food in the desert and the Word of God sustained their spirit.

READING II: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 — We are the Body of Christ when we participate in the Eucharist.

◆ This reading reminds us that the life of Jesus sustains our life and that sharing his life bonds us together as one. We are the body of Christ when we share the Eucharist.

GOSPEL: John 6:51-58 — The Word of God made flesh, Jesus, declared he was the Bread of Life.

◆ This passage reminds us that Jesus is the Word of God made flesh; that Jesus is the Bread of Life and His flesh, given for the world was a pledge of our resurrection.

Saint of the Week

Thérèse of Lisieux

Thérèse of Lisieux OCD (born Marie Françoise-Thérèse Martin; 2 January 1873 – 30 September 1897), religious name **Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face**, was a French Discalced Carmelite who is widely venerated in modern times. She is popularly known in English as the "Little Flower of Jesus", or simply the "Little Flower", and in French as *la petite Thérèse* ("Little Therese").

Therese has been a highly influential model of sanctity for Catholics and for others because of the simplicity and practicality of her approach to the spiritual life. She is one of the most popular saints in the history of the church, although she was obscure during her lifetime. Pope Pius X called her "the greatest saint of modern times".

Therese felt an early call to religious life and, after overcoming various obstacles, in 1888, at age 15, she became a nun and joined two of her elder sisters in the cloistered Carmelite community of Lisieux in Normandy (another sister, Céline, also later joined the order). After nine years as a Carmelite nun, having fulfilled various offices such as sacristan and assistant to the novice mistress, in her last eighteen months in Carmel she fell into a night of faith, in which she is said to have felt Jesus was absent and been tormented by doubts that God existed. Therese died at the age of 24 from tuberculosis.

After her death, Therese became known globally through her spiritual memoir, *The Story of a Soul*, which explains her theology of the "Little Way". As a result of her immense popularity and reputation for holiness, she was quickly beatified and canonized by Pope Pius XI, who completed the process just 28 years after her death. In 1997, Pope John Paul II declared her a Doctor of the Church. Her feast day in the General Roman Calendar was 3 October from 1927 until it was moved in 1969 to 1 October.

She is well known throughout the world, with the Basilica of Lisieux being the second most popular place of pilgrimage in France after Lourdes.

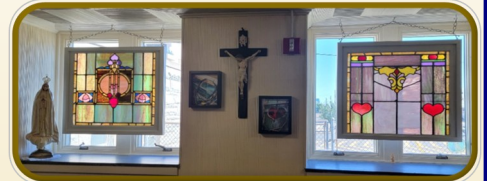

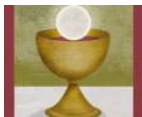

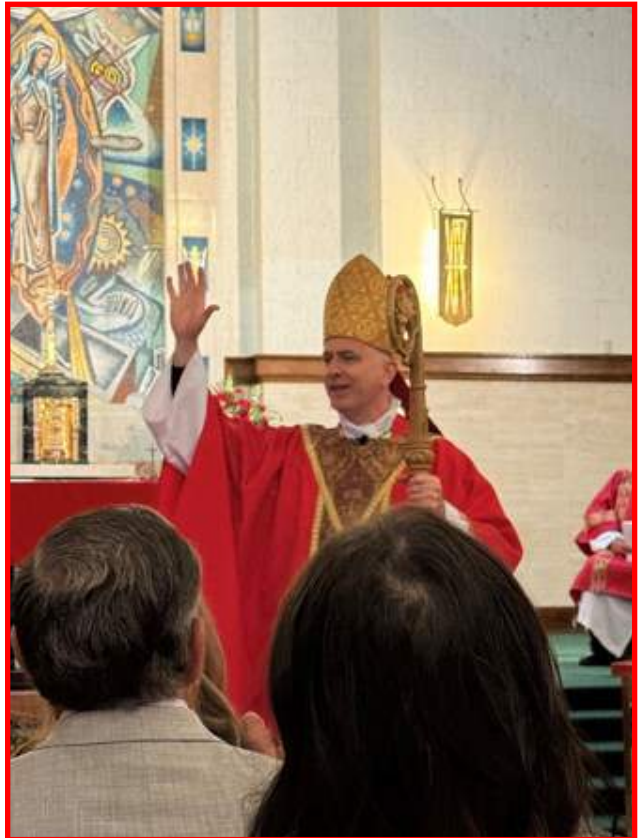
