Letter From Kevin Quinn - Parish Administrator

This weekend we remember in our own special way those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our great nation. Memorial Day is a day when we honor and celebrate the memories of the armed forces who never made it to veteran status because they were killed fighting for their country in wars, police actions, peace-keeping missions or terrorist attacks. It is a day, steeped in tradition, when many veterans honor their fallen comrades, by visiting cemeteries, offering prayers, and placing flags on their graves. Much like All Souls Day, in our Catholic tradition, Memorial Day is a very special day to pray for the war dead and their families who still mourn their loss.

Unofficially, Memorial Day signals the start of the summer season, especially here at the Shore. So, in that spirit I would like to welcome our summer visitors and summer residents back to Notre Dame de la Mer Parish. YEAR OF MERCY

Dear Parishioners,

As we move forward in the “Year of Mercy”, I ask you to consider the words of Jesus, “*When I was thirsty you gave me to drink*”.

Can you answer “yes” to this question?

Can you see Jesus in those you encounter daily?

Can you see Jesus in those who are less fortunate?

In our everyday lives we take clean water and so many other needs for granted, needs that our brothers and sisters in this country and in other countries throughout the world can only “dream” about. In many countries the local river water is used to bathe, to wash, and as drinking water. The luxury of having running water does not even enter into the picture. Yet...

WATER is such a basic need. About two-thirds of the human body is made up of water. Our bodies that have been so wonderfully designed by God are able to go without food for a longer period of time than they can without water. Water is a need we all have and we all possess. The need of the poor is no different than the need of the not so poor.

In the summer of 2016 farm workers on South Jersey farms in the Camden Diocese will work the land and harvest the crops. The Diocese has a farm ministry that reaches out to the migrant workers to provide them with basic needs. One need that the farm workers have is for bottled water when working in the fields in the hot sun. As our June act of Mercy can we help to alleviate this need? Can we offer them a drink of water?

On Sundays, June 5 and June 12 please consider helping our farm workers with bottled water. You can bring in a 6, 12 or 24 pkg. of bottled water to mass with you. ***At Assumption Church please bring the water to Kelly Hall before the start of Mass. At St. Ann Church please bring the water to the front steps of the church.** If you would prefer to make a monetary donation please write a check to NDDLMParish and put the word WATER in the memo area. **There will be envelopes in the rear of church for these checks.**

Misericordiae Vultus

On this “Corpus Christi” Sunday, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus, we Catholics realize that Jesus, the fount of all mercy, gave his very self for all people and He continues to this very day to be present to us, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Jesus waits with open arms to shed his mercies again and again on all who call upon Himand so we wish *countless graces, mercies, blessings and indulgences of this extraordinary Holy Year of Mercy to all who continue to reflect seriously, engage prayerfully and act boldly on Pope Francis’ letter which challenge us in very unique ways to be “Merciful like the Father”.* (MV14)

Pope Francis continues“There is an aspect of mercy that goes beyond the confines of the Church, It relates us to Judaism and Islam, both of which consider mercy to be one of God’s most important attributes. Israel was the first to receive this revelation which continues in history as the source of an inexhaustible richness meant to be shared with all mankind. As we have seen, the pages of the Old Testament are steeped in mercy, because they narrate the works that the Lord performed in favour of his people at the most trying moments of their history. Among the privileged names that Islam attributes to the Creator are “Merciful and Kind”. This invocation is often on the lips of faithful Muslims who feel themselves accompanied and sustained by mercy in their daily weakness. They too believe that no one can place a limit on divine mercy because its doors are always open.

I trust that this Jubilee year celebrating the mercy of God will foster an encounter with these religions and with other noble religious traditions; may it open us to even more fervent dialogue so that we might know and understand one another better; may it eliminate every form of closed-mindedness and disrespect, and drive out every form of violence and discrimination”. (MV 23) *(Let us beg God in his great mercy to help us do this.)*
