Letter From Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

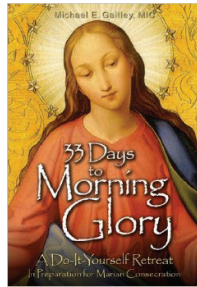
