Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings probably remind us of a loss we have experienced sometime in our lives. But, how have we reacted to our losses. In our first reading today, the people of Israel are experiencing the loss of their homes, and the loss of their sense of direction as they wander for years in the desert. They also fear losing their own lives, forgotten by a God who made promises to them that he seems not to have kept. Perhaps some of us are feeling a loss of our home, or a loved one, and perhaps even a lack of direction; have then, turned to false gods, false loves, to alleviate the pain. Perhaps we are building a golden calf, and begin to worship it rather than the true but invisible God.

God threatens to destroy the Israelites, but Moses intercedes and calls on God to remember the covenant that God made with their ancestors. God did not punish the Israelites perhaps because of Moses' courage in facing him and Moses' earlier doubts.

In today's Gospel, we find a couple more examples of loss. How many of us would leave 99 sheep and go after one who had strayed? We might not – but God would. And again, how many of us would light a lamp to dispel the darkness, and sweep our home in search of one lost coin that we had dropped - and searching for it until it was found? We might not – but God would. There are none of us, not even God, who would lose something of value and not search for it till it was found. We might not – but God would. These parables lead us to our Gospel and the very familiar story of the Prodigal Son. Let's ask ourselves: Which of the two sons are we most like? Luke reminds us that the Father of our house loves us in spite of our behaviors and attitudes.

The father in the parable left the house, in order to greet the first son as he came up the road. Rather than experiencing rejection, the father offers the wayward son, forgiveness. Instead of having an angry reaction to the second son, the father begs the son to come into the house. Often times, we think we know better than the Church and we leave. But even with all of this, our Father invites us into his house again and again.

Today, we honor many sons and daughters, many first responders, all those who lost their lives on 9/11/2001. The attacks killed 2,996 people and injured 6,000 others. Today and everyday let us remember to pray for these heroes from today's world. Let us, also, remember to pray for all those members of our parish community who have suffered the loss of someone dear to them.
